When: Oct 8-9-10

What: A Super Council Wide “jambo” program, complete with world-class stuff to amaze and astound

Who: Open to: SHAC Units, plus maybe the public and even out-of-council units.

Program: Sun and Moon and Stars... and of course, a **Shooting Sports Program**

Needed: At least 50 Instructors, since we will likely be running over a dozen shooting Stations at any time on Saturday, Oct 9.

Cost to participate:

Cost has not been set. There are several ways to actually participate:

- You are a day-tripper support staff person... no troop and no participation in the program outside of shooting sports
- You are there with your unit and you can help out in reserved 2-hour time windows. This is a Commitment!!
- You are on staff for the event and you agree to help out; we reserve your time-window commitment
- You are helping out as a day-tripper, but you want access to the whole program, including meals for staff.
